

Safe and a little bit at home with Bolidt

On top of that, several particular requirements apply to flooring flatness, the floors must be resistant to most common chemicals and because of the great importance of hygiene, no bacteria should be able to flourish in the floor or in connections with vertical construction parts.

Next to the Bolidtop® 525 Stato, the hospital also let Bolidt install the Bolidtop® Select Soft system on its footbridges of steel. These bridges act as transport veins of visitors, patients and beds to create a gateway to all other areas of the hospital and bear much human traffic. The advantages of the Bolidtop® Select Soft systems are therefore very useful to the Maasland hospital! This system namely muffles the sound when walking across and has a flexible, springy effect, enabling the floor to be much more scratch-proof. Because of this, the overall flooring of the footbridges is highly sustainable, looking nice and aesthetic on top of that.
